

We are excited to reopen our doors and welcome you back to our dog training classes, with new classes beginning Tuesday, September 1. We encourage you to sign up.

At Lyons Township Dog Training Club, we place the health and wellbeing of our dogs, students and instructors above all else. To ensure we keep everyone as safe as possible during this time, we are adhering to guidance from the CDC and complying with health and safety directives of the State of Illinois.

Important things to know:

- Only the person training the dog is allowed to enter the Odeum. No extra family members are allowed to attend and observe.
- Mask are required at all times, covering mouth and nose. LTDTTC won't be providing masks.
- Social distancing is required. You must keep a minimum of 6 feet from other students and instructors.
- If you are crating your dog, your crate and belongings need to be 6 feet away from other crates.
- No touching of other people's dogs or belongings. No touching of ring gates or equipment.
- The Odeum will mark certain doorways as Entrance or Exit only. You will be required to follow these designations.
- You will be required to check-in, and attest that you are feeling healthy and are not suspected of exposure to the virus.
- You should not enter the facility any earlier than 10 minutes before your class start time, through a designated entrance.
- You must leave the Odeum as quickly as possible following the conclusion of your class through the nearest designated exit.
- Drinking fountains will not be operating, so you are encouraged to bring your own water.
