Earn an agility title on your beginner dog in a trial atmosphere! The Agility Course Test is an entry level agility event to introduce beginning dogs and/or handlers to the sport of agility. Dogs must be 15 months old to enter and must meet the requirements for a regular agility trial (Chapter 1, Section 3), except that they need not be AKC registered to enter. Dogs with Novice legs are eligible to enter. Dogs with a Novice Title are not eligible to enter.

<u>ACT Level 1</u> is open to all dogs who **have not earned any AKC titles**. The course will have 10-12 obstacles including a 5' A-Frame, table, tunnel, bar jumps (no spreads). Tire and panel jump are allowed but not required. Time for the course will be 60 seconds and a score of 85 is required.

ACT Level 2 is open to all dogs who have not earned any AKC titles except for an ACT1 title. The course will have 11-13 obstacles. All Level 1 obstacles will be used with the addition of a teeter, tire, 1 spread and 6 weaves. Time for the course will be 70 seconds and a score of 85 is required.

Refusals and Run outs are not judged. More than 3 attempts will result in an elimination/failure to perform. Table faults, Wrong courses and Failures to Perform will be judged as in a regular agility class. Examples of failing to perform are not touching the downside of a contact obstacle and knocking down a bar. Two passing scores are needed for a title and can be under the same evaluator.

<u>Jump Heights</u> are at the handler's discretion. Jump Heights are 4,8,12,16,20 & 24 inches. A jump height card and measuring are not required. A measuring wicket will NOT be available.

Closing Date: Entries close and must be received by April 5, 2024.

<u>Entry fee:</u> The entry fee is \$20 per run (including \$5 AKC recording fee), **Please make** checks payable to Lyons Township Dog Training Club.

Entry Limit: 60 runs total

<u>Check in:</u> 6:00-6:15pm. Briefing will be at 6:15 followed by a 5 minute walk thru. ACT 1 will start at approximately 6:20. Tall to small in each class. Dogs must be crated when not in the ring or in line at the gate.

<u>Judging Schedule:</u> ACT 1 – Trial 1 followed by ACT 1 – Trial 2 followed by ACT 2 – Trial 1 followed by ACT 2 – Trial 2.

Awards: A dark green qualifying ribbon will be award to all qualifying dogs at the end of all ACT1 runs and then at the end of all ACT2 runs, no ribbons will be mailed.

<u>Dogs that are not registered with AKC</u> are eligible to participate and their performance will be recorded by AKC under a temporary recording number. This will be emailed to you and must be used when entering any subsequent ACT events. You cannot use that for any other AKC events except for the ACT events.

Entries will be accepted as received. Your entry must be complete and signed or will not be accepted. No phone, email or fax entries will be accepted. Express entries must include a signature waiver allowing them to be accepted without a required signature. Returned checks will not constitute a valid entry and a \$30 charge will be collected in addition to the entry fee. There will be no refunds if your dog is absent, excused or barred from competition. Refunds will be given for bitches in season upon inspection or a letter from a veterinarian.

No dogs are allowed off leash except when in the ring and only enter the ring when the dog before you is out of the ring and gate is closed. Ring size is 90X 60 feet with rubber matting.

Refunds: After the close of entries, refunds minus a \$10 processing fee may be allowed on a case-by-case basis (bitch in season and injury to your dog would be valid reasons to request a refund) if the request is made via email to Gina Cameron LTDTCmembership@gmail.com by 7am the day of the trial. No refunds after 7am.

INSTRUCTIONS

Dogs may be entered in any jump height. There is no Regular or Preferred distinction at AKC's ACT events.

In order to acquire the ACT1 or ACT2 title certificate and have the title added to a dog's record, the dog must be registered/listed with the American Kennel Club. **AKC Canine Partners**SM applications may be accepted at the event and submitted to AKC with the event's results.

Dogs that are not AKC registered/listed may be registered at a later date and receive their ACT title at that time.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine PartnerssM** program should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler Number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
